## ~ DOWNTOWN SITES OF INTEREST ~

- **Illinois & Michigan Canal** is located just west of State Street. **Lock One** of the canal is at Division Street and is the first lock on the historic I & M Canal. The canal began operation in 1848 making it possible to ship products and building materials from Lockport to Chicago and the Great Lakes and from Lockport to the Illinois River and the Mississippi River. The Donnelley Trail next to the canal forms a swath of green along the west side of Historic Lockport.
- **Downtown Historic District:** A Nationally Registered Historic District from 2nd Street to 11th Street, and from the Canal to Hamilton Street. Enjoy seeing the unique neighborhood of architectural gems that are located in the downtown. The east side of the block on State from 9th to 10th Streets, reflects the style and look of the 1870s to 1890s, as much of it was rebuilt after the fire of 1895.
- **Central Square**, 222 E 9th Street, An award winning restored limestone structure built as a school house, is now the location of the offices of the City of Lockport.
- **Gladys Fox Museum**, southwest corner of 9th and Washington. Built in 1840 it is considered the oldest masonry church building in Illinois. Open Mondays and Fridays 1 pm to 4:00 pm or by appointment to view local history exhibits. Call Park District 815-838-1183.
- **Lincoln Landing**, located between 8th & 9th Streets at the I & M Canal. Public Park overlooking the canal featuring descriptive plaques, seating, gardens, and a bronze statue of Abraham Lincoln. It was originally a landing for canal boats and passengers and is now a popular site for events.

- **Gaylord Building**, a National Trust For Historic Preservation Site at 8th Street and the I & M Canal. Winner of the 1988 President's Historic Preservation Award. Home to the Lockport Visitors Center, Gallery 7 and Public Landing Restaurant. [www.gaylordbuilding.org](http://www.gaylordbuilding.org). 815-838-9400.
- **Norton Building** at 10th Street and the canal, built circa 1850. At one time, it was the largest stone building in Illinois. Landmarks Illinois Award winning restoration. The ISM Lockport Gallery on the first floor offers a variety of changing art exhibits and events. - **Scale House and Scale House Plaza Garden** at 10th Street and the I & M Canal. Grain wagons were weighed full then empty to learn the weight of grain sold. The grain was then stored in the Norton building to be loaded onto canal boats and shipped to the east and west from Lockport. The Scale House Plaza Garden planted in 2016 was sponsored by Main Street Lockport incorporation with the City of Lockport.
- **Civilian Conservation Corps Shelter**, is located on Canal Street between 11th and 12th Streets. It is also accessible from the I & M Canal trail footbridge at 12th Street. Built circa 1935, it is an example of the beautiful design and construction of CCC structures built in the US. during that era.
- **CN Garden** at 10th Street west of the railroad tracks. The garden was planted with a grant from the CN Railroad for sustainable gardens in cooperation with the City of Lockport and Main Street Lockport. The garden was designed by Marcy Stewart Pyziak.

- **Will County Historical Society Museum**, 803 S. State Street, is located in the original Canal Commissioners office built in the 1830's. View changing exhibits showing collections of Will County history. Please call for hours, 815-838- 5080
- **Heritage Village**, operated by the Will County Historical Museum, is located on the I & M Canal Trail at 2nd Street. Park at 2nd Street and the I & M Canal. View a collection of historic Will County nineteenth and twentieth century buildings in an outdoor village setting.
