APRIL 4, 2023 CONSOLIDATED GENERAL ELECTION

<u>TUESDAY</u>, <u>SEPTEMBER 20</u>, <u>2022</u> – **FIRST DAY** to circulate petitions for independent candidates and new political party candidates.

MONDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2022 – FIRST DAY for independent and new political parties to file nomination petitions and certificates of nomination.

MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2022 – LAST DAY for independent and new political parties to file nomination petitions and certificates of nomination. (City of Lockport, City Clerk's Office will remain open until 5:00 p.m.)

MONDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2022 – LAST DAY for filing State of Economic Interests as required by the Illinois Government Ethics Act, they are to be filed at the County Clerk's Office. The Receipt of Economic Interest must be filed with nomination petitions and certifications of nomination at the City Clerk's Office. (City of Lockport, City Clerk's Office will remain open until 5:00 p.m.)

<u>TUESDAY</u>, <u>DECEMBER 27</u>, <u>2022</u> – <u>LAST DAY</u> to file objections to nomination petitions of new political party, nonpartisan, and independent candidates.

<u>WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 28, 2022 – LAST DAY</u> to conduct Lottery. Lottery shall be conducted when two (2) or more petitions are received simultaneously for the same office by more than one (1) independent candidate or more than one (1) new political party candidate; or by more than one(1) nonpartisan candidate, as of the opening hour of the filing period (December 12, 2022).

SIMULTANEOUSLY PETITION FILING - LOTTERY

All petitions filed by individuals waiting in line at the Office of the City Clerk of Lockport as of 8:00 a.m. the normal opening hour of such office on the first day of filing are considered simultaneous filings. Petitions filed by mail and received in the Office of the City Clerk in the first mail delivery or pick-up on the first day of filing are also considered simultaneous filings. All petitions received thereafter are filed in the order of actual receipt.

When two or more petitions are simultaneously filed for the same office, the local election official shall break ties and determine the order of filing by means of a lottery or other fair and impartial method of random selection approved by the State Board of Elections.

The City Clerk's Office will remain open until 5:00 p.m. on the last day for filling.
